APPROVAL OF MINUTES

REPORTS

1. Budget Presentations: Presentation of the Fiscal Year 2022 General Fund

Cornelia Kent, Chief Financial Officer, introduced Olutomi Adebo, Assistant Budget Officer, to provide presentation of the Fiscal Year 2022 General Fund.

Ms. Adebo reported that the Committee will be reviewing the FY'22 Budget prior to presenting to the full Commission for adoption. At the April 7, 2021 HOC Board meeting, there was a presentation of a balanced budget for the agency.

There was discussion among the Committee in regards to the deficits incurred by Lasko Manor and MetroPointe.

There was no formal action required for full Commission approval.

2. Budget Presentation: Presentation of the Fiscal Year 2022 Public Fund

Olutomi Adebo, Assistant Budget Officer, provided a presentation indicating that the HAP funding increased and there was a decrease in expenses based on a decrease in utilization resulting in a surplus. She reported that the revised utilization projections result in a decrease in administrative income and a decrease in fees paid to the Agency for overhead. The Fatherhood Program was awarded a grant for another five-years and was increased. No increases received thus far for McKinney or the FSS ROSS grants.

Terri Fowler, Budget Officer, provided an explanation in regards to the HAP Administrative Fees.

There was no formal action required for full Commission approval.
